# Background & History

## Forum on Conservation & Harvest Planning

- Started as a 2007 DFO conference call to discuss sharing of limited Fraser sockeye for FSC fisheries
- First in-person meeting hosted by DFO in 2008
- Evolved informally as a venue for Tier 1 & Tier 2 discussions supporting annual fishery planning
- Moved to being hosted by FRAFS
- Joint Forum Planning Committee established
- Joint Technical Working Group established to support engagement of technical staff in advance

# Why a Forum Renewal?

- Fraser Salmon Collaborative Management Agreement (FSCMA) signed in 2019 between the FSMC and DFO
- Forum hosting transitioned to the FSMC
- Interest from delegates, FSMC, and DFO to improve the Forums and reform them to reflect the FSCMA
- COVID and Agreement implementation challenges delayed this work
- 2022 FSCMA governance workshops identified a review of the Forum process as a key piece of strategic planning.

# Renewal Process

- The Forum Planning Committee, FSMC and DFO have identified support and funding to undertake work this fiscal and into next.
- Marc LaBrie and Tawney Lem from West Coast Aquatic have agreed to support and guide this work
- They will be supported by a small group from the Forum Planning Committee including: Greg Witzky, Matthew Parslow, Kristin Hrapchak, Amy Wakelin, Ken Malloway and Victor Isaac

- Review governance recommendations and FSCMA context

- West Coast Aquatic will be conducting interviews with delegates and interested parties

- FPC small group to support WCA's work
