Context

- The Fraser Salmon Management Council (FSMC) is a mandated Indigenous organization with 77 Member Nations from the Fraser River and approach waters
- In 2019, the FSMC and DFO signed the Fraser Salmon Collaborative Management Agreement (FSCMA)
- Establishes a shared governance structure including:
 - Executive (single representative from each Party)
 - Fraser Salmon Management Board (four reps per Party)
 - Joint Technical Committee (five reps per Party)
- The FSMC, and the Parties, also undertake work outside of the workplan agreed to by the FSMB on areas of interest, including supporting this session



Visions Planning

- Planning of this Visions conference was undertaken by the Forum Planning Committee
- Topics suggested for this session included collaborative governance, monitoring, rebuilding, and FSC sharing.
- Monitoring and rebuilding were chosen as:
 - Monitoring continues to be a key issue raised during engagements on an annual basis, particularly how improvements could be supported.
 - Engagement in rebuilding work is a key opportunity to address declining salmon abundance, and represents an opportunity for leadership by First Nations communities to change positively impact the outlook for Fraser Salmon stocks.
